Weight for each was determined by colored stickers:

- 1st – 3pts
- 2nd – 2pts
- 3rd – 1pt

Listed below are the identified issues weighted by priority:

1. Housing (Affordable) – 48
2. Supporting vulnerable populations – 13
3. Employment (supported) - 12
4. Networking /Collaboration – 12
5. Support for children/youth/family - 11
6. Education and awareness campaigns / Increasing capacities - 10
7. Empowering Indigenous Ways / Bridging Relationships – 8
8. Poverty / Homelessness - 8
9. Empowering Women – 5
10. Navigating systems and Social services
11. Physical activity/ Healthy lifestyle - 0
12. Youth safety – 0

There were other specific issues identified that were not captured in entirety.
